**MRS. SARAH HOKE
DIES AT HER HOME
NEAR SPRING GROVE**

Spring Grove, May 30.—Mrs. Sarah Ann Hoke, widow of Michael Hoke, died at 5:15 a. m. today at her home in Jackson township, near Spring Grove, of paralysis following an illness of more than a week. She was aged 77 years, 3 months and 4 days.
