Herbert L. Horn, grocer at 258 Chestnut street, became ill early this morning and died, at about 5:10 o'clock, while being taken to the York hospital. He was pronounced dead upon arrival at the hospital. Mr. Horn was 61 years old. Deputy Coroner Herman B. Sell signed the death certificate. He said death was caused by hemorrhage and asthma. Mr. Horn leaves his wife, Emma Lark Horn; two daughters and two sons, Mrs. Margaret Whitmore and LeRoy Horn, at home; Mrs. Eleanora McCleary, 131 North Queen street, and Herbert L.
