Mary D. Samis Wrightsville

Mary D. Samis of Wrightsville died of natural causes at 1:15 p.m. yesterday at York County Hospital and Home. She was 80.

She was retired as the secretary of the former Colonial Savings Association of Wrightsville.

A 1928 graduate of Wrightsville High School, Mrs. Samis was a member of the Wrightsville Presbyterian Church, Wrightsville High School Alumni Association, Wrightsville Historical Society, Auxiliary of the Abel-Poff-Leithiser American Legion Post of Wrightsville and Knitting Club of York and a volunteer for the Kreuz Creek Valley Library.

Mrs. Samis was born in Hallam and was a daughter of the late Albert and Ellen Sipe Druck. She was the wife of the late William T. Samis.
